MAIN FEATURES

THE *BCXP PRO* CAN BE CONNECTED TO MOST KEYBOARDS/SYNTHS WITH A PEDAL INPUT JACK FOR CONTROLLING THE VOLUME, EXPRESSION OR OTHER ASSIGNABLE PARAMETERS.

- BCXP PRO HAS AN INPUT 1/8" JACK TO CONNECT THE YAMAHA BC3ATM.
- **BCXP PRO** HAS AN INPUT JACK TO CONNECT AN EXPRESSION PEDAL.
- *BCXP PRO* IS LINEAR (0-127).
- **BCXP PRO** HAS A REVERSE BUTTON FOR REVERSING THE TIP & RING.
- **BCXP PRO** HAS TWO LED INDICATORS 1. GREEN = BATTERY IS FULL 2. YELLOW = BATTERY IS LOW.
- **BCXP PRO** IS POWERED BY USING 9v BATTERY OR D.C 9v POWER SUPPLY (REGULATED).



(SIDE VIEW)




(FRONT VIEW)

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BCXP PRO SETUP GUIDE



(SETUP DIAGRAM FIG. 1)

Note: You will need a stereo jack (TRS) to connect the BCXP PRO to your Expression / Pedal input of your device. (see FIG. 1). Mono cable will not work with the BCXP PRO.

STEPS (for most Keyboards/ Synthesizers)

- 1. Install a 9v Battery in the BCXP PRO or use a 9v regulated power adapter (not included)
- 2. Connect the Output of the BCXP PRO (**EXPRESSION PDEAL / OUTPUT**) by using a TRS cable to the Pedal input of your Keyboard/Synth.
- 3. Assign the Pedal Input of your Keyboard/Synth. to Expression if not already setup by default. (refer to the owner's manual of your keyboard/synth)
- 4. Connect the YAMAHA BC3ATM to the 1/8" input jack of the BCXP PRO (**BC**)
- 5. Turn ON the BCXP PRO
- 6. Adjust the GAIN CONTROL of the BC3 (GAIN) by dialing to the very right (MAX GAIN)
- 7. Adjust the Offset Value Control (**OFFSET**) of the BC3 by not blowing so that playing the keys will not produce any sound when breath is not applied.

CALIBRATING THE BCXP PRO WITH THE Korg Pa800/Pa2x Pro


STEPS (disconnect both the BC3 and the TRS cable from the BCXP PRO)

- 1. Adjust the Reverse Switch (**Tip/Ring**) of the BCXP PRO to Positive (upward)
- 2. Turn the BCX PRO ON (**PWR. ON/OFF**)
- 3. Apply step 1 from above
- 4. Connect the TRS cable to the Pedal input of the Korg Pa800/Pa2x Pro.
- 5. PRESS GLOBAL (KORG PA800/PA2X PRO)
- 6. Select Controllers
- 7. Select Pedal/Switch
- 8. Assign it a function: Keyboard Expression
- 9. Connect the TRS cable to the Output of the BCXP PRO (see FIG. 1)
- 10. Connect the YAMAHA BC3ATM to the 1/8" input jack of the BCXP PRO (**BC**)
- 11. Adjust the GAIN CONTROL of the BC3 (GAIN) by dialing to the very right (MAX GAIN)
- 12. Rotate the Offset Value Control (**OFFSET**) of the BC3 to the very left



- 13. Adjust the Offset Value Control (**OFFSET**) of the BC3 by rotating clockwise so the second marker of the (**OFFSET**) is in the center of the (**GAIN**)
- 14. Select Calibration. The following dialog box appears:



- 15. Place the Mouthpiece of the BC3 in your mouth and blow to the maximum level
- 16. Touch the "Push" button in the display to confirm the maximum value. The following dialog box appears:



- 17. Touch the "Push" button in the display to confirm the minimum value.
- 18. Save by choosing the "Write Global-Global Setup" command from the page menu.
- 19. Adjust the Offset Value Control (**OFFSET**) of the BC3 by not blowing so that playing the keys will not produce any sound when breath is not applied.
- 20. Play the keys while blowing into the BC3.
